

### Delirium

Poor concentration, seeing things

Agitation

Talking to themselves, confusion

Hypoactive (drowsy, sleepy)

Hyperactive (restless, agitated)



### Chest Pain

Distress, feeling of impending dread

Rapid breathing

Agitation

Sweating, nausea, vomiting

Heavy, tight, crushing feeling in chest

Indigestion-type pain, pain in jaw/arm



## Dyspnoea

Breathing quickly or noisily

Agitation, confusion

Sweating, fever

Short of breath at rest or on movement

Cough (dry or moist)



## Dehydration

Dry tongue, lips and skin

Constipation, diarrhea, vomiting

Decreased bodily fluids, dark urine

Agitation/confusion

Fatigue, unwilling to do activities



#### **UTIS**

Agitation, restlessness, confusion

Pain/burning when passing urine

Fatigue, tiredness, lack of appetite

Smelly, cloudy milky or bloody urine

Increased toileting, incontinence aid or bed changes, can't control or pass urine



# Constipation

Stools less than 3 times a week, more than 2 days without passing stool

Hard and dry pellets, stool stuck or unable to pass

Nausea or lack or appetite

Feeling of fullness or cramps

Agitation, restlessness



### Falls

Recent illness, frailty, delirium, or return from hospital

New to the home

Decreased walking and activity recently

Resident not wearing glasses, hearing aids or footwear

Not using mobility aids



## Palliative Care

Increased agitation, confusion, tiredness

Increased pain and distress

Unable to perform usual activities

Worsening condition and disease progression

Decreasing alertness and reduced diet and fluid intake
