Training Session Options

Each activity/scenario: 20 minutes

These training sessions are an extension of the initial training and includes ten specific scenarios for RNs & ENs to explore their knowledge of early detection of deterioration:

Scenario based:

- Case 1: Delirium
- Case 2: Chest pain - cardiac failure, pulmonary oedema, dyspnoea
- Case 3: Chest Pain – cardiac
- Case 4: Dyspnoea
- Case 5: Dehydration
- Case6: UTI
- Case 7: Constipation
- Case 8: Falls
- Case 9: Palliative Care - frailty
- Case 10: Palliative care – CVA/stroke, pain

Other:

- Communication: Escalation & Reporting
- Review: RN/EN Quiz
